AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," further providing for expenses of delegates and
5 officers who attend the State association annual meeting.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 622 of the act of June 24, 1931
9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and
11 amended May 16, 1985 (P.L.34, No.16), is amended to read:

12 Section 622. Expenses of Delegates Paid by Townships.--Each
13 delegate and other officer attending the annual meeting of the
14 State association shall be allowed for his expenses incurred in
15 attending the meeting, [not to exceed ninety dollars per day]
16 the actual expenses incurred for lodging plus twenty-five
17 dollars for meals, gratuities and other expenses for EACH OF not <—
18 more than four days including the time employed in traveling
19 thereto and therefrom, together with mileage going to and

1 returning from the meeting. In addition, the registration or
2 similar fee incurred in connection with attending the annual
3 meeting shall be an allowable expense. These expenses shall be
4 paid by the respective townships.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
