## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for restoration of operating
- 3 privileges.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1545 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1545. Restoration of operating privilege.
- 9 Upon the restoration of any person's operating privilege
- 10 which has been suspended [or revoked pursuant to this
- 11 subchapter,] under section 1539 (relating to suspension of
- 12 operating privilege on accumulation of points), such person's
- 13 record shall show five points, except that any additional points
- 14 [assessed against the person] assigned to the person's record
- 15 since the date of the last violation resulting in the suspension
- 16 [or revocation] shall be added to such five points unless the
- 17 person has served an additional period of suspension [or

- 1 revocation] pursuant to section 1544(a) (relating to additional
- 2 period of revocation or suspension). [This section shall not
- 3 apply to section 1533 (relating to suspension of operating
- 4 privilege for failure to respond to citation).]
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
