AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto," permitting interests in police pension funds to vest after 12 years under certain conditions; providing for the amount of the retirement allowance benefit vested; and adding a definition.
8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), known
11	as The Third Class City Code, reenacted and amended June 28,
12	1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended by adding a section to read:
13	Section 4302.1. Limited Vested Benefit(a) The ordinance
14	may provide for a limited vested benefit if such would conform
15	to section 305 of the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005,
16	No.205), known as the "Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard
17	and Recovery Act." Under the provisions of the benefit, should a
18	member of the police pension fund, before completing the minimum
19	age and minimum period of continuous service requirements but

1	after having completed twelve years of full-time service, the
2	member shall be entitled to vest his or her retirement benefits
3	subject to the following conditions:
4	(1) the member must file with the management board of the
5	police pension fund a written notice of his or her intention to
6	<u>vest;</u>
7	(2) the member must include in the notice, the date the
8	member intends to terminate his or her service as a full-time
9	<pre>police officer;</pre>
10	(3) the termination date shall be at least thirty days later
11	than the date of notice to vest;
12	(4) the member must be in good standing with the police
13	department on the date of notice to vest; and
14	(5) the board shall indicate on the notice to vest the rate
15	of the monthly pay of the member as of the date of said notice
16	to vest or the highest average annual salary which the member
17	received during any five years of service preceding said date,
18	whichever is the higher.
19	(b) Upon reaching the date which would have been the
20	member's retirement date had the member continued his or her
21	full-time employment with the police department, the member
22	shall notify the board, in writing, that the member desires to
23	collect his or her pension. The amount of retirement benefits
24	the member is entitled to receive under this section shall be
25	computed as follows:
26	(1) the initial determination of the member's base
27	retirement benefits shall be computed on the salary indicated on
28	the notice to vest; and
29	(2) the portion of the base retirement benefits due the
30	member shall be determined by applying to the base amount the
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percentage that his or her years of service actually rendered
 bears to the years of service which would have been rendered had
 the member continued to be employed by the department until his
 or her minimum retirement date.

5 Section 2. Section 4303(a) of the act, amended May 9, 1961
6 (P.L.178, No.88), is amended to read:

7 Section 4303. Allowances and Service Increments.--(a) Payments for allowances shall not be a charge on any other fund 8 9 in the treasury of the city or under its control save the police 10 pension fund herein provided for. The basis of the apportionment 11 of the pension shall be determined by the rate of the monthly pay of the member at the date of injury, death, honorable 12 13 discharge, vesting under section 4302.1 or retirement, or the 14 highest average annual salary which the member received during 15 any five years of service preceding injury, death, honorable 16 discharge, vesting under section 4302.1 or retirement, whichever 17 is the higher, and except as to service increments provided for 18 in subsection (b) of this section, shall not in any case exceed 19 in any year one-half the annual pay of such member computed at 20 such monthly or average annual rate, whichever is the higher. 21 * * *

Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read: <u>Section 4309. Definitions.--As used in this subdivision the</u> term "salary" is defined as the total income paid to the member <u>by the city FIXED AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION PAID AT REGULAR,</u> PERIODIC INTERVALS, BY THE CITY TO THE MEMBER, AND from which pension contributions have been deducted.

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28 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
