18	Section 705. Standing to Challenge Residency of Certain
19	OfficialsNotwithstanding any provision of law to the
20	contrary, the following person shall have the authority to
21	challenge the legal residency of an elected county or municipal
22	<u>officer:</u>
23	(1) any elected county official;

1	(2) any elected official of a municipality located within
2	the county; and
3	(3) for the residency of an elected official of a
4	municipality not a county, any elected official of that
5	municipality.
б	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
