AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled 2 "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize 3 and bargain collectively through selected representatives; defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit 5 organizations and institutions; providing compulsory 6 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining 7 impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes 8 for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and 9 10 employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public 11 employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; 12 providing penalties for violations; and establishing procedures for implementation, " requiring daily negotiating 13 14 sessions when there is a strike in a school entity. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 17 Section 1. The act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known 18 as the Public Employe Relations Act, is amended by adding a 19 section to read: 20 Section 808. (a) Whenever a strike occurs in a school 21 entity, representatives of the public employer and the employe organizations shall be required to attend daily negotiating 22

sessions under the direction of the Bureau of Mediation, or

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- 1 participate in fact-finding as specified in this article, until
- 2 <u>a collective bargaining agreement is reduced to writing and</u>
- 3 signed by the parties.
- 4 (b) As used in this section, the term "school entity" means
- 5 <u>a school district</u>, <u>area vocational-technical school or</u>
- 6 intermediate unit.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
