## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the utilization of field
- 3 receipts.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 926(a) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 926. Acknowledgment of guilt and receipt for payment.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A person charged with violating any
- 10 provision of this title which is a summary offense may sign\_
- 11 within ten days of the commission of the offense, an
- 12 acknowledgment of the offense committed and pay to an officer of
- 13 the commission the penalty in full, as fixed by this title, plus
- 14 any costs of prosecution which may have accrued. The printed
- 15 receipt for this payment shall only prove full satisfaction of
- 16 the monetary fine for the offense committed and in no way shall

- 1 limit the commission from further revoking hunting and furtaking
- 2 privileges.

- Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or 4
- 5 immediately, whichever is later.
