AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the display of obscene material on motor vehicles.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 5905. Obscene material displayed on motor vehicles.
9	<u>A person commits a misdemeanor of the second degree if he</u>
10	knowingly displays any obscene material, as defined in section
11	5903 (relating to obscene and other sexual materials), on any
12	sticker, decal, emblem or other device attached to a motor
13	<u>vehicle.</u>
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
