AN ACT

1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for lifetime resident fishing
3 licenses for former prisoners of war.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2701 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 2701. Resident fishing licenses.

10 (c) Lifetime license for prisoners of war.--Any former
11 prisoner of war whose imprisonment while in the service of the
12 armed forces of the United States is certified by the
13 appropriate branch of the armed forces and who complies with
14 subsection (a)(1) and (2) may, in lieu of purchasing an annual
15 resident fishing license, purchase a "Lifetime Resident Fishing
16 License" which shall be valid for the applicant's lifetime upon

1 the payment of a fee of \$50 for the use of the Commonwealth and,
2 in the event the license is issued by an issuing agent, a fee of
3 50¢ for the use of the issuing agent.

4 Section 2. This act shall apply to the license year
5 beginning January 1, 1990, and each year thereafter.

6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
