- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for senior resident license
- 3 qualifications.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2705(3) and (6) of Title 34 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 2705. Classes of licenses.
- 9 Unless otherwise provided, any person wishing to exercise any
- 10 of the privileges granted by this title shall first secure the
- 11 applicable resident or nonresident hunting or furtaking license
- 12 as follows:
- 13 * * *
- 14 (3) Senior resident hunting licenses or, at the option
- of the applicant, a senior lifetime resident hunting license
- 16 to residents who have reached or will reach their 65th

- 1 birthday [prior to the date] <u>in the year</u> of the application
- for the license. The commission shall develop, implement and
- 3 administer a system to provide tags, report cards and
- 4 applications to those residents who hold a senior lifetime
- 5 resident hunting license issued under this paragraph. The
- 6 system shall require the applicant or license holder to pay
- any approved fee assessed by the issuing agent.

- 9 (6) Senior resident furtaking licenses or, at the option
- of the applicant, a senior lifetime resident furtaking
- license to residents who have reached <u>or will reach</u> their
- 12 65th birthday [prior to the date] <u>in the year</u> of the
- 13 application for the license.
