## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 26, 1961 (P.L.1661, No.692), 2 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for group life 3 insurance for State employes; establishing a schedule; providing for payment; and providing for administration and 5 advisory services by the Department of General Services," further providing that benefits shall continue and not be 7 reduced upon retirement. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of September 26, 1961 11 (P.L.1661, No.692), known as the State Employes Group Life 12 Insurance Law, amended December 12, 1984 (P.L. 973, No. 192), is 13 amended to read: 14 Termination of Life Insurance.--(a) Section 5. 15 insurance on any eligible employe shall cease on termination of 16 employment or upon nonpayment of any contribution due from an 17 employe or after twelve continuous months of unpaid absence, 18 subject to any conversion privilege, provided that the life insurance will be continued for employes who terminate after 19 becoming permanently and totally disabled while covered under 20

- (b) Upon retirement of any eligible employe, the insurance 2
- 3 shall continue without abatement or reduction in benefits for
- 4 any reason. Likewise, there shall be no abatement or reduction
- in benefits for a disabled retiree. 5
- 6 Section 2. Section 5(b) of the act shall be retroactive to
- 7 October 1, 1976.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
