AN ACT

1 2	Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
6	necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the
7	University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1989, to
8	June 30, 1990, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:
9	(1) For instruction, excluding Veterinary
10	Medicine programs and Doctor of Medicine 15,545,000
11	(2) For dental clinics
12	(3) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine
13	program
14	(4) For instruction in Veterinary Medicine
15	programs only
16	(5) For the New Bolton Animal Center 3,509,000
17	(6) For the Center for Animal Health and

- 2 (7) For food and animal clinics and services.. 1,890,000
- 3 Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on
- 4 account of the appropriations for the items provided in section
- 5 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the
- 6 basis of costs during the fiscal year.
- 7 Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide such
- 8 information as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of
- 9 this act and in such form and manner as the Department of
- 10 Education shall prescribe.
- 11 Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its
- 12 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
- 13 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
- 14 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
- 15 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
- 16 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
- 17 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
- 18 Related Colleges and Universities."
- 19 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or
- 20 immediately, whichever is later.
