AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Philadelphia College of
- 2 Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$5,240,000 \$5,607,000 is hereby
- 6 appropriated to the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic
- 7 Medicine, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 1989, to
- 8 June 30, 1990, for instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy
- 9 program.
- 10 Section 2. Payments to the Philadelphia College of
- 11 Osteopathic Medicine on account of the appropriation provided in
- 12 section 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education
- 13 on the basis of costs during the fiscal year.
- 14 Section 3. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine
- 15 shall provide such information as may be necessary to carry out
- 16 the provisions of this act and in such form and manner as the
- 17 Department of Education shall prescribe.

- 1 Section 4. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine
- 2 shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its
- 3 financial statements in accordance with generally accepted
- 4 accounting principles and procedures for educational
- 5 institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance
- 6 Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget
- 7 Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State-
- 8 Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and
- 9 Universities."
- 10 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or
- 11 immediately, whichever is later.
