## AN ACT

Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for creditable 3 nonstate service. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5304(c) of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania 6 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended October 21, 1988 (P.L.844, No.112), is amended to read: 8 § 5304. Creditable nonstate service. 9 10 (c) Limitations on nonstate service. -- Creditable nonstate 11 service credit shall be limited to: 12 intervening military service; 13 14 other military service not exceeding five years; 15 service in any public school or public educational institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in 16 any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United 17

States; or service as an administrator, teacher, or

- 1 instructor in the field of education for any agency or
- department of the government of the United States, whether or
- 3 not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United
- 4 States, the total of such service not exceeding the lesser of
- 5 ten years or the number of years of active membership in the
- 6 system, as an officer or employee of the Department of
- 7 Education or as an administrator, teacher, or instructor
- 8 employed in any State-owned educational institution or The
- 9 Pennsylvania State University;
- 10 (4) previous service with a governmental agency other
- 11 than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was
- terminated because of the transfer by statute of the
- administration of such service or of the entire agency to the
- 14 Commonwealth;
- 15 (5) service as a temporary Federal employee assigned to
- an air quality control complement for the Pennsylvania
- 17 Department of Environmental Resources at any time during the
- 18 period of 1970 through 1975. This service time may be
- 19 purchased only if the member makes an election to purchase
- 20 within one year of the effective date of this paragraph, and
- 21 the member shall pay an amount which is equal to the full
- 22 actuarial cost of the increased benefit obtained by virtue of
- the purchase as provided in section 5505(f);
- 24 (6) service in the Cadet Nurse Corps with respect to any
- 25 period of training as a student or graduate nurse under a
- 26 plan approved under section 2 of the act of June 15, 1943
- 27 (Public Law 78-73, 57 Stat. 153), if the total period of
- training under such plan was at least two years, the credit
- for such service not to exceed three years; [or]
- 30 (7) service prior to July 1, 1971, at a community

- 1 college established under the act of August 24, 1963
- 2 (P.L.1132, No.484), known as the Community College Act of
- 3 1963[.]; or
- 4 (8) previous service with a redevelopment authority
- 5 <u>established pursuant to the act of May 24, 1945 (P.L.991, No.</u>
- 6 385), known as the Urban Redevelopment Law, not exceeding the
- 7 lesser of ten years or the number of years service with an
- 8 authority.

- 10 Section 2. Section 5505 of Title 71 is amended by adding a
- 11 subsection to read:
- 12 § 5505. Contributions for the purchase of credit for creditable
- 13 nonstate service.
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (q) Purchase of authority service. -- The amount due for the
- 16 purchase of credit for service with an authority shall be
- 17 <u>determined by applying the member's basic contribution rate, the</u>
- 18 additional contribution rate plus the Commonwealth's normal
- 19 contribution rate for active members at the time of entry,
- 20 <u>subsequent to such service with an authority, of the member into</u>
- 21 State service to his average annual rate of compensation over
- 22 the first three years of such subsequent State service and
- 23 <u>multiplying the result by the number of years and fractional</u>
- 24 part of a year of creditable service with an authority being
- 25 <u>purchased together with statutory interest during all periods of</u>
- 26 <u>subsequent State service to date of purchase. Upon application</u>
- 27 for credit for such service, payment shall be made in a lump sum
- 28 within 30 days, or in the case of an active member it may be
- 29 <u>amortized with statutory interest through salary deductions in</u>
- 30 amounts agreed upon by the member and the board. Application may

- 1 be filed for all such credit for service with an authority upon
- 2 <u>completion of three years of subsequent State service and shall</u>
- 3 <u>be credited as Class A service.</u>
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
