## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, " providing for instruction in Braille 5
- for certain students.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1373.2. Instruction in Braille. -- School districts
- 13 shall provide instruction in Braille to all school age children
- 14 who are blind and to all partially sighted children who are in
- 15 apparent need and/or whose parents request Braille instruction.
- NEED AND WHOSE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS REQUEST BRAILLE INSTRUCTION, 16

- 1 <u>IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
