## AN ACT

Amending the act of January 24, 1966 (1965 P.L.1535, No.537), 2 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the planning and 3 regulation of community sewage systems and individual sewage systems; requiring municipalities to submit plans for systems 5 in their jurisdiction; authorizing grants; requiring permits 6 for persons installing such systems; requiring disclosure 7 statements in certain land sale contracts; authorizing the 8 Department of Environmental Resources to adopt and administer rules, regulations, standards and procedures; creating an 9 advisory committee; providing remedies and prescribing 10 11 penalties," further providing for certain areas within which 12 on-lot sewage disposal is prohibited. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 7(b) of the act of January 24, 1966 (1965) P.L.1535, No.537), known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities 17 Act, is amended by adding a paragraph to read: Section 7. Permits. -- \* \* \* 18 19 (b) \* \* \* 20 (5.1) The department shall not establish an area within 21 which on-lot sewage systems are prohibited unless that area is

delineated by clearly defined and ascertainable boundaries, nor

- 1 shall the department establish such an area unless the
- 2 <u>department provides sufficient evidence to the affected local</u>
- 3 agency that the area under the prohibition is served by an
- 4 <u>existing sewer line or where that area could be served by the</u>
- 5 construction or extension of a sewer line, where such
- 6 <u>construction or extension could be performed in an efficient</u>
- 7 manner and at a reasonable cost. The department shall not
- 8 <u>establish boundaries delineating an area within which an on-lot</u>
- 9 <u>sewage system is prohibited where the boundary line would divide</u>
- 10 or cross through the real estate property or place an entire
- 11 real estate property within the boundary line itself.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
