## AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), entitled
  "An act establishing a program of limited pharmaceutical
  assistance for the elderly; granting powers to and imposing
  duties on the Department of Aging; establishing a payment
  system; making provisions for funding; providing for reports;
  and fixing penalties for violations of the pharmaceutical
  assistance program, further defining maximum annual
  income."

- 11 Section 1. The definition of "maximum annual income" in
- 12 section 3 of the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), known
- 13 as the Pharmaceutical Assistance Contract for the Elderly Act,
- 14 amended December 17, 1984 (P.L.1002, No.202), is amended to

- 16 Section 3. Definitions.
- 17 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 18 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 19 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 2 "Maximum annual income." Annual income as determined by the
- 3 department. Such amount shall not exceed [\$12,000] \$20,000, both
- 4 in the case of single persons [nor \$15,000] and in the case of
- 5 the combined annual income of married persons.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
