AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled 2 "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting 3 unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties," 4 5 requiring health care insurers to pay certain claims within 30 days of receipt of a notice of claim. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 5(a)(10) of the act of July 22, 1974 10 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act, 11 is amended by adding a subparagraph to read: 12 Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or 13 Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined .-- (a) "Unfair methods of competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the 14 15 business of insurance means:
- 17 (10) Any of the following acts if committed or performed

- (xvi) Refusing to pay a claim submitted under major medical 3

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
