AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261), entitled 2 "An act requiring the licensing of practitioners of
- 3 osteopathic medicine and surgery; regulating their practice;
- 4 providing for certain funds and penalties for violations and
- 5 repeals, "providing for the assessment of fees from
- 6 applicants and licensees for the Rural Medical Student
- 7 Scholarship and Physician Loan Repayment Fund.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261),
- 11 known as the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act, is amended by
- 12 adding a section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 10.1. Additional fee assessment.</u>
- 14 (a) Each applicant for licensure and each biennial
- 15 registrant shall be assessed the sum of \$20 in addition to any
- 16 other reasonable fees set by the board.
- 17 (b) The board shall forward the fees collected under the
- 18 provisions of this section to the Rural Medical Student

- 1 Scholarship and Physician Loan Repayment Fund in the
- 2 <u>Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
