## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, increasing the penalty for scattering rubbish; and making a repeal.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6501(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes, amended May 31, 1990 (P.L.219, No.47), is
8	amended to read:
9	§ 6501. Scattering rubbish.

11	(b) Penalty
12	(1) A person who violates subsection $(a)(1)$ or $(2)$ is
13	guilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon
14	conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not
15	less than \$50 nor more than \$300 or to imprisonment for not
16	more than 90 days, or both.
17	(2) A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is

1 guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree for the second 2 and subsequent offense and upon conviction thereof shall be 3 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$300 nor more than 4 \$1,000. The person also may be sentenced to imprisonment or 5 to performing a community service for a period not to exceed 6 one year.

7 (3) A person who violates subsection (a)(3) is guilty of 8 a misdemeanor of the second degree for the first offense and 9 upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of 10 not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000. The person also may 11 be sentenced to imprisonment or to performing a community 12 service for a period not to exceed two years.

(4) A person who violates subsection (a)(3) is guilty of
a misdemeanor of the first degree for the second or
subsequent offense and upon conviction thereof shall be
sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than
\$10,000. The person also may be sentenced to imprisonment or
to performing a community service for a period not to exceed
five years.

20 (5) Any vehicle, equipment, or conveyance, including any 21 private automobile and small truck, used for the 22 transportation or disposal of trash, garbage or debris in the 23 commission of a second or subsequent offense under subsection 24 (a)(3) may be deemed contraband and forfeited in accordance 25 with the provisions set forth in this section.

(6) (i) In addition to the penalties provided for in
 this subsection, the court may order the suspension of
 the violator's motor vehicle operating privilege for 30
 days.

4	(7) The community service referred to in this subsection
5	shall include, but not be limited to, the collection of
6	rubbish along streets and highways. The minimum period for
7	this service shall be for three hours per day for 30 days. A
8	term of community service may be imposed only if the
9	penalties provided for in paragraph (6) are not imposed. If
10	the penalties in paragraph (6) are imposed, community service
11	shall not be imposed.
