- 1 Commemorating the 125th Anniversary of the Confederate Burning of Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, on July 30, 1989.
- 3 WHEREAS, During the Civil War, Confederate Troops occupied
- 4 the town of Chambersburg and demanded exorbitant ransom demands
- 5 which were denied by the citizens; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Troops torched the town of Chambersburg, making it
- 7 the only northern town burned by the Confederates during the
- 8 Civil War; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The hardworking residents of Chambersburg remained
- 10 in their town and raised an ashen pile of rubble that signified
- 11 the agony of the Civil War and rebuilt their town; therefore be
- 12 it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the
- 14 125th Anniversary of the Burning of Chambersburg and remember
- 15 the citizens of the town who endured and reconstructed
- 16 Chambersburg in the aftermath of this terrible event.
