Making appropriations from a restricted revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal augmentation funds to the 3 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are specifically appropriated from the restricted revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal 8 augmentation funds to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission 9 to provide for the operation of the commission for the fiscal 10 11 year July 1, 1989, to June 30, 1990, for the purposes and in the 12 amounts shown: 13 Federal State For the salaries, wages 14 15 and all necessary expenses for the 16 proper operation and administration 17 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, excluding the chairman
