10	Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128,
11	No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the

15	is amended by adding a subsection to read:
16	Section 1. * * *
17	(d) In addition to any other powers and duties imposed by
18	this section the Governor shall require the Department of
19	General Services to furnish official POW/MIA Flags for entrances
20	to State-owned bridges which have been named in honor of war

- 1 veterans, which flags shall be installed and continuously
- 2 <u>displayed by the Department of Transportation until all POW's</u>
- 3 and MIA's return or are accounted for.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
