- 1 THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 2 GENERAL SERVICES TO DISPLAY CONTINUOUSLY FROM A FLAG POLE IN
- 3 "SOLDIERS' GROVE," AS DEFINED IN THE ACT OF OCTOBER 30, 1987
- 4 (P.L.375, NO.75), ENTITLED "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION
- 5 OF CERTAIN TREES AND LAND ON THE GROUNDS OF THE STATE CAPITOL IN
- 6 HARRISBURG AS 'SOLDIERS' GROVE' IN HONOR OF WAR VETERANS;
- 7 IMPOSING DUTIES UPON THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES; AND

- 17 to State-owned bridges which have been named in honor of war
- 18 veterans, which flags shall be installed and continuously
- 19 displayed by the Department of Transportation until all POW's
- 20 and MIA's return or are accounted for.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
