## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 7 8 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections, providing for voter registration in certain State 11 12 offices. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a 16 17 section to read: 18 Section 705. Voter Registration in State Offices. -- The Department of State shall, by regulation, establish a Statewide 19 system of voter registration in certain State offices. These 20

regulations shall include, but not be limited to, the following

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- 1 provisions:
- 2 (1) A "State office" shall include, but not be limited to, a
- 3 State employment office operated by the Department of Labor and
- 4 <u>Industry and a State welfare office operated by the Department</u>
- 5 of Public Welfare.
- 6 (2) State employes at these offices shall inquire of each
- 7 person visiting the office, whether the person, if not
- 8 registered to vote, wishes to register to vote.
- 9 (3) Standard voter registration forms shall be provided to
- 10 those persons wishing to register to vote.
- 11 (4) The correct addresses of the appropriate county
- 12 registration commissions shall be provided to those persons
- 13 <u>wishing to register to vote.</u>
- 14 (5) State offices shall provide reasonable space for
- 15 <u>nonpartisan signs or posters encouraging voter registration</u>
- 16 which will be provided by the Department of State.
- 17 (6) State offices shall provide a box for depositing
- 18 completed voter registration forms. These forms shall be
- 19 promptly forwarded to the appropriate county registration
- 20 <u>commissions by the participating State office.</u>
- 21 (7) State offices shall conduct themselves in a manner
- 22 consistent with the following principles:
- 23 (i) All voter registration activities will be nonpartisan in
- 24 <u>nature</u>.
- 25 (ii) The decision as to whether to register to vote is
- 26 voluntary on the part of each person.
- 27 (iii) No person shall be denied any claim or benefits based
- 28 on his decision whether or not to register to vote.
- 29 (8) All nonpartisan voter registration activities will be in
- 30 compliance with Federal and State laws.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
