5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 441.1 of the act of June 13, 1967
8	(P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, added July
9	31, 1968 (P.L.904, No.273), is amended to read:
10	Section 441.1. Persons Eligible for Medical AssistanceThe
11	following persons shall be eligible for medical assistance:
12	(1) Persons who receive or are eligible to receive cash
13	assistance grants under this article;
14	(2) Persons who meet the eligibility requirements of this
15	article for cash assistance grants except for citizenship,
16	durational residence and any eligibility condition or other
17	requirement for cash assistance which is prohibited under Title
18	XIX of the Federal Social Security Act; [and]
19	(3) The medically needy[.]; and

1	(4) Children under five years of age and pregnant women
2	whose income is one hundred fifteen percent of the Federally
3	determined poverty level for the fiscal year 1991-1992; children
4	under six years of age and pregnant women whose family income is
5	at or less than one hundred twenty-five percent of the Federally
б	determined poverty level for the fiscal year 1992-1993; children
7	under seven years of age and pregnant women whose family income
8	is at or less than one hundred fifty percent of the Federally
9	determined poverty level for the fiscal year 1993-1994, and
10	children under eight years of age and pregnant women whose
11	family income is at or less than one hundred eighty-five percent
12	of the Federally determined poverty level for the fiscal year
13	1994-1995, consistent with the provisions of Federal law
14	relating to the medical assistance program. For the purpose of
15	this section, these recipients shall be entitled to the medical
16	assistance benefits available to persons deemed categorically
17	needy as provided for in clause (1), consistent with services
18	eligible for Federal financial participation.
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

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
