AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for speed limits on State roads  
3 in the vicinity of schools.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3365(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3365. Special speed limitations.

10 (b) School zones.--When passing a school zone as defined and  
11 established under regulations of the department, no person shall  
12 drive a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour. An  
13 official traffic-control device shall indicate the beginning and  
14 end of each school zone to traffic approaching in each  
15 direction. On State roads containing posted school zones, the  
16 speed limit shall not exceed 35 miles per hour for a distance of  
17 2,000 feet immediately preceding the official traffic-control  
18 device. Establishment of a school zone, including its location

1 and hours of operation, shall be approved by the department.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
