## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for the passing of streetcars.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 3315. Passing streetcars.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision in
- 9 this subchapter, the driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and
- 10 pass to the left of any streetcar proceeding in the same
- 11 direction, whether actually in motion or temporarily halted to
- 12 receive or discharge passengers, if the overtaking or passing
- 13 requires driving in a lane normally used by traffic moving in
- 14 the opposite direction.
- 15 (b) Passenger safety.--No driver of a vehicle shall overtake
- 16 and pass a streetcar that has stopped to receive or discharge
- 17 passengers on the side which the passengers board or alight

- 1 until the doors of the streetcar are closed and the passengers
- 2 that are discharged have reached the side of the highway. Where
- 3 <u>a platform or pedestrian zone exists or where traffic is</u>
- 4 controlled by a peace officer or a traffic signal, a vehicle
- 5 need not be brought to a full stop before passing the streetcar,
- 6 but may proceed past the streetcar at a speed not greater than
- 7 35 miles per hour and with due caution for the safety of
- 8 pedestrians.
- 9 (c) Penalty.--A person who violates this section commits a
- 10 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 11 a fine of \$300 or to imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or
- 12 both.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
