11 REMAINING UNPAID ON JUNE 30, 1991.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

4 OF PUBLIC WELFARE DURING THE FISCAL
5 PERIOD 1991-1992 WHICH ADDS TO THE
6 COST OF ANY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
7 SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ONLY FROM AND AFTER
8 THE DATE UPON WHICH IT IS APPROVED AS
9 TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS BY THE
10 GOVERNOR.

11 SECTION 2. TREASURY DEPARTMENT.--
12 THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS ARE APPROPRIATED
13 TO THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT:
14 FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT SERVICE
15 OR TO PAY ALL ARBITRAGE REBATES TO THE
16 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT REQUIRED UNDER
17 SECTION 148 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE
18 CODE OF 1986 (PUBLIC LAW 99-514, 26
19 U.S.C. § 148).
