AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Delaware Valley College of Science
2 and Agriculture at Doylestown.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum of \$344,000 is hereby appropriated to the
6 Delaware Valley College of Science and Agriculture at
7 Doylestown, for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992,
8 for instruction and student aid. The final payment totaling no
9 less than 25% of this appropriation is contingent on the
10 Secretary of Education certifying to the General Assembly that
11 the Delaware Valley College of Science and Agriculture has fully
12 cooperated in the Department of Education's efforts to fulfill
13 the requirements of the higher education accountability
14 appropriation to the Department of Education.

15 Section 2. In addition to the sum appropriated under section
16 1, the sum of \$150,000 is hereby appropriated to the Delaware
17 Valley College of Science and Agriculture at Doylestown, for the

1 fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, for the James A.
2 Michener Center for the Arts.

3 Section 3. Payments to the Delaware Valley College of
4 Science and Agriculture on account of the appropriation provided
5 in section 1 shall be made by the Secretary of Education in
6 equal quarterly payments.

7 Section 4. The Delaware Valley College of Science and
8 Agriculture shall provide full, complete, and accurate
9 information as may be required by the Department of Education or
10 the Majority or Minority Chairman of the Appropriations
11 Committee of the Senate or the Majority or Minority Chairman of
12 the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

13 Section 5. The Delaware Valley College of Science and
14 Agriculture shall report its revenues and expenditures and
15 present its financial statements in accordance with generally
16 accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational
17 institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance
18 Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget
19 Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State-
20 Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and
21 Universities."

22 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or
23 immediately, whichever is later.
