AS RE-REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, JULY 25, 1991

## AN ACT

1 2	Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry, Philadelphia.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. The sum of $\$1,247,000$ $\$1,662,000$ is hereby <—
6	appropriated to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry,
7	Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30,
8	1992, for instruction. The final payment totaling no less than
9	25% of this appropriation is contingent on the Secretary of
10	Education certifying to the General Assembly that the
11	Pennsylvania College of Optometry has fully cooperated in the
12	Department of Education's efforts to fulfill the requirements of
13	the higher education accountability appropriation to the
14	Department of Education.
15	Section 2. Payments to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry
16	on account of the appropriation provided in section 1 shall be

made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of

- 1 costs during the fiscal year.
- 2 Section 3. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall
- 3 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be
- 4 required by the Department of Education or the Majority Chairman
- 5 or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 6 Senate or the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the
- 7 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 8 Section 4. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall
- 9 report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
- 10 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 11 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
- 12 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the
- 13 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State
- 14 System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-
- 15 State-Related Colleges and Universities."
- 16 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or
- 17 immediately, whichever is later.
