AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, "further providing for kindergartens.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 503 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 9 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended
- 10 September 21, 1959 (P.L.925, No.373) and October 21, 1965
- 11 (P.L.601, No.312), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 503. Kindergartens.--(a) The board of school
- 13 directors in any school district may establish and maintain
- 14 kindergartens for children between the ages of [four] three and
- 15 six years. When established, the kindergartens shall be an
- 16 integral part of the elementary school system of the district,
- 17 and be kept open for not less than two and one-half hours each
- 18 day for the full school term as provided in section 1501.

- 1 (b) The number of kindergartens in any one district shall be
- 2 fixed by the board of school directors, and shall be open during
- 3 the school year. When established, kindergartens shall be
- 4 available to all children in residence of the school district
- 5 who are of the age fixed by the board of school directors
- 6 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
- 7 [If the average attendance in any one kindergarten in any
- 8 district is ten or less for the school year, the school
- 9 directors shall, at the close of the school year, discontinue
- 10 the same.]
- 11 (c) The board of school directors shall appoint and assign a
- 12 sufficient number of teachers to such kindergartens, who shall
- 13 be certified in accordance with the rules and regulations
- 14 prescribed by the [Council of Basic Education] State Board of
- 15 Education.
- 16 (D) KINDERGARTEN PUPILS LESS THAN FIVE YEARS OF AGE SHALL BE <-
- 17 EXEMPT FROM PARTICIPATING IN STANDARDIZED ACHIEVEMENT TESTING
- 18 PROGRAMS THAT MAY BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DISTRICT.
- 19 (E) THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT CURRICULUM
- 20 REGULATIONS THAT ARE DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE FOR CHILDREN
- 21 BEING INSTRUCTED BETWEEN THE AGES OF THREE AND SIX.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1991, or
- 23 immediately, whichever is later.
