A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for the continuance of the budget of the preceding year in the event that a new budget is not adopted by July 1.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby resolves as follows:
7	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
8	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
9	That section 12 of Article VIII be amended to read:
10	§ 12. Governor's budgets and financial plan.
11	(a) Annually, at the times set by law, the Governor shall
12	submit to the General Assembly:
13	[(a)] <u>(1)</u> A balanced operating budget for the ensuing
14	fiscal year setting forth in detail (i) proposed expenditures
15	classified by department or agency and by program and (ii)
16	estimated revenues from all sources. If estimated revenues and
17	available surplus are less than proposed expenditures, the
18	Governor shall recommend specific additional sources of revenue

sufficient to pay the deficiency and the estimated revenue to be
 derived from each source;

3 [(b)] <u>(2)</u> A capital budget for the ensuing fiscal year 4 setting forth in detail proposed expenditures to be financed 5 from the proceeds of obligations of the Commonwealth or of its 6 agencies or authorities or from operating funds; and

7 [(c)] <u>(3)</u> A financial plan for not less than the next
8 succeeding five fiscal years, which plan shall include for each
9 such fiscal year:

10 (i) Projected operating expenditures classified by 11 department or agency and by program, in reasonable detail, and 12 estimated revenues, by major categories, from existing and 13 additional sources, and

14 (ii) Projected expenditures for capital projects
15 specifically itemized by purpose, and the proposed sources of
16 financing each.

17 (b) In the event a general appropriation bill is not finally 18 enacted prior to July 1 of the fiscal year to which it relates, the General Appropriation Act and other acts appropriating 19 20 moneys from the General Fund in effect for the preceding fiscal 21 year shall on July 1 be deemed to have been reenacted for the 22 new fiscal year and be applicable to the new fiscal year, 23 together with any amendments to that General Appropriation Act 24 and other acts appropriating moneys from the General Fund 25 finally enacted by the General Assembly during the new or 26 preceding fiscal year. The General Assembly by law may prescribe 27 procedures for carrying out this subsection and may provide for 28 the effect of the final enactment of a general appropriation 29 bill and other appropriation bills on or after July 1 of the fiscal year to which it relates. 30
