## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 19, 1984 (P.L.1093, No.219),
- 2 entitled "An act relating to noncoal surface mining
- 3 conservation and reclamation, "exempting from licensing and
- 4 permitting a person who mines a certain quantity of
- 5 flagstone.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of December 19, 1984
- 9 (P.L.1093, No.219), known as the Noncoal Surface Mining
- 10 Conservation and Reclamation Act, is amended by adding a
- 11 definition to read:
- 12 Section 3. Definitions.
- 13 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 14 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 15 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 17 <u>"Flagstone." A hard sandstone, usually micaceous and fine-</u>
- 18 grained, that occurs in extensive thin beds with shale partings.

- 3 Section 5. Operator's license.
- \* \* \* 4
- 5 (g) Exemption. -- This section shall not apply to a person who
- mines 1,000 tons or less of flagstone per year. 6
- 7 Section 7. Mining permit; reclamation plan.
- \* \* \* 8
- 9 (d) Exemption. -- This section shall not apply to a person who
- 10 mines 1,000 tons or less of flagstone per year.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
