AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), entitled "An 2 act providing for the administration of a statewide system of vital statistics; prescribing the functions of the State 3 Department of Health, the State Advisory Health Board and local registrars; imposing duties upon coroners, prothonotaries, clerks of orphans' court, physicians, 7 midwives and other persons; requiring reports and certificates for the registration of vital statistics; 8 9 regulating the disposition of dead bodies; limiting the 10 disclosure of records; prescribing the sufficiency of vital statistics records as evidence; prescribing fees and 11 penalties; and revising and consolidating the laws relating 12 thereto, " providing for issuance of records without fee for 13 14 certain firemen or law enforcement officers. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 17 Section 1.
