1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	Amending the act of July 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, No.208), entitled, as amended, "An act authorizing the indebtedness, with the approval of the electors, of fifty million dollars for loans to volunteer fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and volunteer rescue squads for the purpose of establishing or modernizing facilities to house fire fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, and for purchasing new fire fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, protective and communications equipment, and any other accessory equipment necessary for the proper performance of such organizations' duties," adding fire company relief associations to the definition of "volunteer fire company."

20	Section 3. DefinitionsAs used in this act:

22	"Volunteer fire company" means any nonprofit chartered

1 corporation, association or organization, or fire company relief 2 association connected therewith, located in this Commonwealth 3 which provides fire protection services and other voluntary 4 emergency services within the Commonwealth. Voluntary emergency 5 services provided by a volunteer fire company may include 6 voluntary ambulance and voluntary rescue services.
