14	Section 1. Section 13 of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,
15	No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
16	Cosmetic Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
17	Section 13. Prohibited Acts; Penalties* * *
18	(n) In addition to the sentences provided in this section
19	for offenses involving the use or possession of controlled
20	substances, every defendant so convicted shall also be sentenced
21	to an indefinite term which shall terminate when the defendant
22	reveals the identity of the person who supplied the drugs

- 1 related to the original offense.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
