AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 7 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," authorizing county boards of elections to place 11 nonbinding referendums on ballots. 12
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 302 of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333,
- 16 No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by
- 17 adding a clause to read:
- 18 Section 302. Powers and Duties of County Boards. -- The county
- 19 boards of elections, within their respective counties, shall
- 20 exercise, in the manner provided by this act, all powers granted
- 21 to them by this act, and shall perform all the duties imposed

- upon them by this act, which shall include the following:

- (p) To place nonbinding proposals on the ballot in a manner 3
- 4 <u>fairly representing the content of a petition for decision by</u>
- 5 <u>referendum at an election</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
