AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- 2 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth, "further providing for
- 4 eligibility for medical assistance.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 441.1 of the act of June 13, 1967
- 8 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, added July
- 9 31, 1968 (P.L.904, No.273), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 441.1. Persons Eligible for Medical Assistance.--The
- 11 following persons shall be eligible for medical assistance:
- 12 (1) Persons who receive or are eligible to receive cash
- 13 assistance grants under this article;
- 14 (2) Persons who meet the eligibility requirements of this
- 15 article for cash assistance grants except for citizenship,

- 1 durational residence and any eligibility condition or other
- 2 requirement for cash assistance which is prohibited under Title
- 3 XIX of the Federal Social Security Act; [and]
- 4 (3) The medically needy[.]; and
- 5 (4) Without being subject to the requirements of section
- 6 442.1(2), any welfare recipient who obtains full-time gainful
- 7 employment but only for the lesser of one year or until the
- 8 former recipient obtains health care benefits.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
