AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 4 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," further providing for classes of income. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 303(a)(1) of the act of March 4, 1971 14 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, amended 15 March 13, 1974 (P.L.179, No.32), is amended to read: 16 Section 303. Classes of Income. -- (a) The classes of income 17 referred to above are as follows:

Compensation. All salaries, wages, commissions, bonuses

- 12 Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to August 1, 1990.
