AN ACT

1 2	Making an appropriation to the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. The sum of \$5,607,000 is hereby appropriated to
б	the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia,
7	for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, for
8	instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy program.
9	Section 2. Payments to the Philadelphia College of
10	Osteopathic Medicine on account of the appropriation provided in
11	section 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education
12	on the basis of costs during the fiscal year.
13	Section 3. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine
14	shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be
15	required by the Department of Education or the Majority Chairman
16	or the Minority Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
17	Senate or the Majority Chairman or the Minority Chairman of the

1 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

2 Section 4. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine 3 shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted 4 accounting principles and procedures for educational 5 institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance 6 Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget 7 8 Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State-9 Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and Universities." 10

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1992, or immediately, whichever is later.
