## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 9, 1992 (P.L. , No.39A), entitled "An act appropriating money from the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of Commerce for various projects throughout this Commonwealth for fiscal year 1992-1993," further defining a project; and making an appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $2(1)$ of the act of July 9, 1992 (P.L. , No.39A), entitled "An act appropriating money from the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of Commerce for various projects throughout this Commonwealth for fiscal year 1992-1993," is amended to read:

Section 2. The following amounts are appropriated to the Department of Commerce to induce companies to locate large industrial, manufacturing or research and development enterprises within this Commonwealth:
(1) For the purpose of making a loan to Murry's, Inc., a vertically integrated meat and poultry processing company, to expand its existing
facility in Lebanon through the acquisition of
land, the construction of an 80,000 square foot
processing and distribution facility [in the city
of Lebanon's enterprise zone.] within Lebanon
County and the acquisition of machinery and
equipment. Murry's, Inc., will invest at least
$\$ 12,000,000$ into the project, which will create
approximately 200 new jobs within three years of
