## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 24, 1951 (P.L.1304, No.315), 2 entitled, as amended, "An act to improve local health 3 administration throughout the Commonwealth by authorizing the creation, establishment and administration of single-county 4 5 or joint-county departments of health in all counties; 6 exempting certain municipalities from the jurisdiction of single-county or joint-county departments of health; permitting the dissolution of departments or boards of health 7 8 9 in certain municipalities; authorizing State grants to 10 counties which establish departments of health and to certain 11 municipalities if they meet prescribed requirements; conferring powers and duties upon the State Department of 12 13 Health in connection with the creation, establishment and 14 administration of single-county or joint-county departments of health and administration of the health laws in parts of 15 16 certain municipalities not subject to the jurisdiction of 17 single-county or joint-county departments of health, and the administration of State grants; and repealing an act which 18 19 confers health powers upon counties of the first class," 20 restricting authority to impose plumbing occupational 21 licensing requirements. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- 25 (P.L.1304, No.315), known as the Local Health Administration
- 26 Law, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 27 Section 11. Powers and Duties of the County Board of

- (d) The board of health shall not be authorized to impose 3
- 4 <u>occupational licensing requirements for plumbers and plumbing in</u>
- 5 municipalities unless otherwise required by statute.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
