## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Supporting the United States Armed Forces personnel in their
- 2 mission in the Persian Gulf War.
- 3 WHEREAS, On August 2, Saddam Hussein and his Iraqi military
- 4 forces invaded and annexed the peaceful nation of Kuwait; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The United Nations officially condemned this armed
- 6 aggression and adopted a resolution which authorized the United
- 7 States and certain other nations to use whatever force is
- 8 necessary after January 15, 1991; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The United States Congress, by resolution, gave
- 10 President Bush the authority to compel Iraq to leave Kuwait; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The armed forces of the United States have, together
- 12 with a coalition of other nations, begun the liberation of
- 13 Kuwait; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Some people have protested against the use of United
- 2 States troops in a combat role in the Persian Gulf War;
- 3 therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby
- 5 demonstrates its wholehearted support for all our troops in the
- 6 Persian Gulf War; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 the President of the United States, presiding officers of each
- 9 house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 10 Pennsylvania.
