A RESOLUTION

1 Relating to the extended school year program for autistic  
2 children and other special education students with  
3 disabilities.

4 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives finds that, for  
5 autistic children and other special education students with  
6 disabilities, the extended school year program is essential due  
7 to the fact that repetition is an integral part of the child's  
8 education plan; and

9 WHEREAS, The extended school year program provides additional  
10 education through the summer months for autistic and other  
11 special education students; and

12 WHEREAS, The extended school year program has recently been a  
13 source of controversy and debate concerning its benefits to  
14 special education students; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the  
16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania instruct the Secretary of Education  
17 to review the extended school year program and to provide the  
18 General Assembly with a report as to the implications that such

1 a program will have on autistic children and other special  
2 education students with disabilities; and be it further  
3 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of Education submit this report  
4 within 90 days from the passage of this resolution.
