## A RESOLUTION

Designating June 15, 1991, as "Operation Desert Storm Day" in Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, United States and coalition armed forces have achieved remarkable success in defeating Iraqi Military Forces and ousting them from Kuwait; and

WHEREAS, American men and women placed themselves at risk to stem the tides of aggression and further the cause of democracy; and

WHEREAS, This victory advances the cause of peace and justice and sets back the forces of tyranny and oppression; and

WHEREAS, In an effort to liberate Kuwait, all of the servicemen and servicewomen who served in coalition forces were subject to hardship, peril, extreme danger and loss of life; and

WHEREAS, Many of the members of our armed forces who served in Operation Desert Shield and Operation Desert Storm were residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim June 15, 1991, as "Operation Desert Storm Day" in Pennsylvania in recognition of the military victory in the Persian Gulf and in honor of the participation of the United States Armed Forces in this accomplishment.
