1 Recognizing Chuck Noll for his career as the Head Coach of the 2 Pittsburgh Steelers. 3 WHEREAS, Chuck Noll retired as Head Coach of the Pittsburgh 4 Steelers on December 26, 1991, after 23 seasons; and 5 WHEREAS, During his tenure, the Pittsburgh Steelers qualified 6 for playoff competition 12 times and won four World 7 Championships; and WHEREAS, During his tenure, Chuck Noll led the Pittsburgh 8 9 Steelers to eight consecutive playoff appearances from the 1971 10 season through the 1978 season and to four Super Bowl victories in 1975, 1976, 1979 and 1980, thus earning the team the status 11 12 of the National Football League's Team of the 70's; and 13 WHEREAS, Chuck Noll is the only head coach to win four Super 14 Bowls; and
