A RESOLUTION

- 1 Declaring the week of November 18 through 25, 1992, as "American 2 Gem Society Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The American Gem Society, a nonprofit organization,
- 4 was founded in 1934 by Robert M. Shipley for the purpose of
- 5 assuring consumers that any purchases they make meet the highest
- 6 standards of the jewelry industry; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Members of the American Gem Society throughout the
- 8 United States and Canada work to educate the public about their
- 9 comprehensive training and certification programs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The American Gem Society has established rigid
- 11 criteria for acceptance which must be met by member jewelers.
- 12 These criteria include continuing education courses offered
- 13 through the Gemological Institute of America, examinations and
- 14 an annual certification process; and
- 15 WHEREAS, There are now more than 60 stores throughout the
- 16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with registered jewelers and
- 17 certified gemologists and appraisers approved by the American

- Gem Society on staff; therefore be it 1
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 3 week of November 18 through 25, 1992, as "American Gem Society
- 4 Week" in Pennsylvania.
