## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.384, No.81), entitled "An  
2 act providing for the inspection of amusement rides and  
3 attractions; granting powers and imposing duties on the  
4 Department of Agriculture; creating the Amusement Ride Safety  
5 Advisory Board; and imposing civil and criminal penalties,"  
6 providing for the Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.384,  
10 No.81), known as the Amusement Ride Inspection Act, is repealed.

11 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

12 Section 5. Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.

13 (a) Establishment.--There is hereby established under the  
14 jurisdiction of the department a board known as the Amusement  
15 Ride Safety Advisory Board.

16 (b) Composition.--The board, appointed by the Governor,  
17 shall consist of ~~nine~~ TEN members of whom one member shall be a <—  
18 representative of the amusement ride manufacturers, ~~one~~ TWO <—  
19 shall be a ~~representative~~ REPRESENTATIVES of the Pennsylvania <—

1 State ~~Showman's~~ SHOWMEN'S Association, two shall be <—  
2 representatives of the Pennsylvania Amusement Park Association,  
3 one shall be a representative of the Pennsylvania State  
4 Association of County Fairs, one shall be a mechanical engineer  
5 and two shall represent the public. The ~~secretary~~ SECRETARY OF <—  
6 AGRICULTURE OR HIS DESIGNEE shall be designated by the Governor  
7 as the chairman.

8 (c) Terms of members.--The members of the board shall serve  
9 at the pleasure of the Governor. All members shall serve until  
10 their successors are appointed and qualified. Vacancies shall be  
11 filled by appointment for the unexpired term in the same manner  
12 as the original appointments.

13 Section 3. Section 19 of the act is repealed.

14 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
