AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.384, No.81), entitled "An
- act providing for the inspection of amusement rides and
- 3 attractions; granting powers and imposing duties on the 4 Department of Agriculture; creating the Amusement Ride Safety
- 5 Advisory Board; and imposing civil and criminal penalties,"
- 6 providing for the Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.384,
- 10 No.81), known as the Amusement Ride Inspection Act, is repealed.
- 11 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 Section 5. Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.
- 13 (a) Establishment. -- There is hereby established under the
- 14 jurisdiction of the department a board known as the Amusement
- 15 Ride Safety Advisory Board.
- 16 (b) Composition. -- The board, appointed by the Governor,
- 17 <u>shall consist of nine TEN members of whom one member shall be a <-</u>
- 18 representative of the amusement ride manufacturers, one TWO <-
- 19 shall be a representative REPRESENTATIVES of the Pennsylvania

- 1 State Showman's SHOWMEN'S Association, two shall be
- 2 representatives of the Pennsylvania Amusement Park Association,

- 3 <u>one shall be a representative of the Pennsylvania State</u>
- 4 Association of County Fairs, one shall be a mechanical engineer
- 5 and two shall represent the public. The secretary SECRETARY OF
- 6 AGRICULTURE OR HIS DESIGNEE shall be designated by the Governor
- 7 as the chairman.
- 8 (c) Terms of members.--The members of the board shall serve
- 9 at the pleasure of the Governor. All members shall serve until
- 10 their successors are appointed and qualified. Vacancies shall be
- 11 filled by appointment for the unexpired term in the same manner
- 12 <u>as the original appointments.</u>
- 13 Section 3. Section 19 of the act is repealed.
- 14 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
