- 1 Amending the act of August 6, 1963 (P.L.521, No.277), entitled
- 2 "An act providing that probation officers shall have the
- 3 power of peace officers in the performance of their duties,"
- 4 further providing for powers of probation officers.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of August 6, 1963 (P.L.521,
- 8 No.277), entitled "An act providing that probation officers
- 9 shall have the power of peace officers in the performance of
- 10 their duties," is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1. Probation officers heretofore or hereafter
- 12 appointed by any court of record of this Commonwealth are hereby
- 13 declared to be peace officers, and shall have police powers and
- 14 authority throughout the Commonwealth to arrest with or without
- 15 warrant, writ, rule or process, any person on probation,
- 16 <u>intermediate punishment</u> or parole under the supervision of said
- 17 court for failing to report as required by the terms of his
- 18 probation, intermediate punishment or parole or for any other

- 1 violation of his probation, intermediate punishment or parole.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 2
